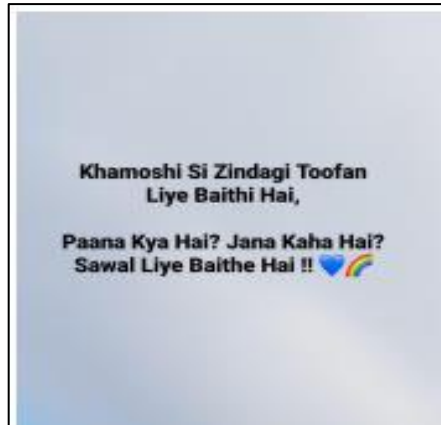

Report on “Poetry and Shayri event”

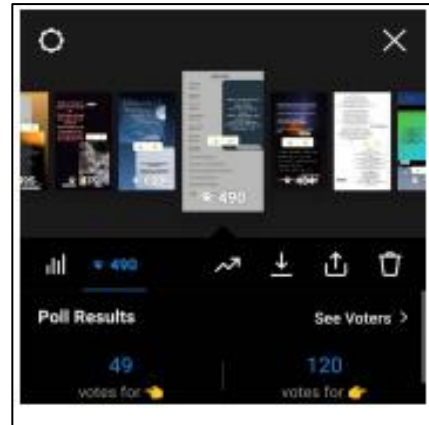

Report on “Universal Human Values”

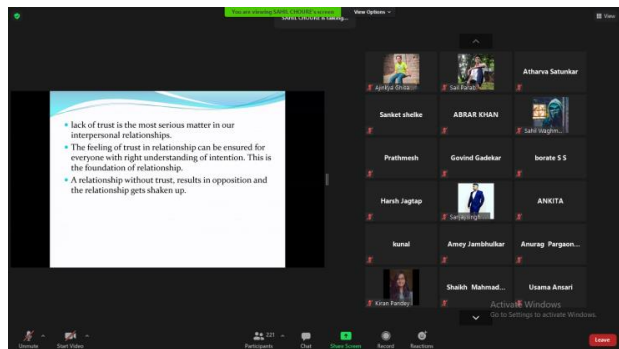
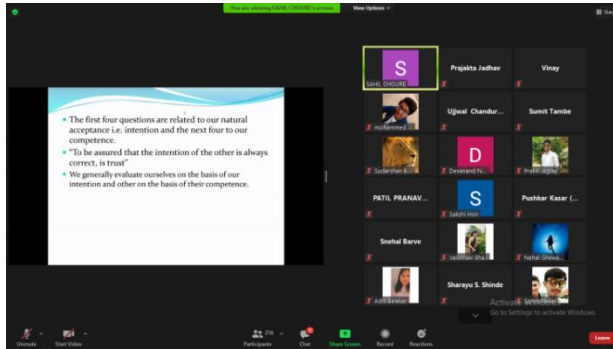

We Team conducted the Vaccination drive in order to keep the students and staff protected from corona virus. Covid-19 Vaccination program was organized on 28th October 2021 in the College campus library from 10 am to 4 pm. Around 81 students, 19 staff members and 23 non-teaching staff were given Covi shield/Coaxing vaccine first and second doses as per their vaccination schedule. As this village mostly included farmers, an evening time was considered best as most individuals could be available in their homes at the eve. The event started at 6:30 pm. There was a total strength of 25 boys and Program officer Dr. A.J. Rajguru sir. As the village was sub divided into multiple Wadis (lanes), the total strength was further divided into 6 teams including 4 students as well as a team leader was appointed amongst the team itself. Each team had a target to survey at least 10 households. 10 copies of a survey form were distributed amongst each team. The form included various necessary questions to have a valuable survey. Each team was ascending to their lane (Wadi). An

instruction was given, to complete the task and regather in an hour at gram panchayat office of the village where the event was actually initialized, After the survey was completed, a meeting was organised where everyone shared their experience. According to everyone it was crystal clear that the survey was conducted very successfully. Every resident was very co-operative as well as polite which made this process interactive. Primary occupation is farming in almost every family. The resident of the village was pretty satisfied with the cleanliness, medical system, and water resources of the village. The noticeable point was that the literacy rate of the village was actually appreciable. And the carry-on cake was the fact that in many households, the females were more literate as well as self-dependent.



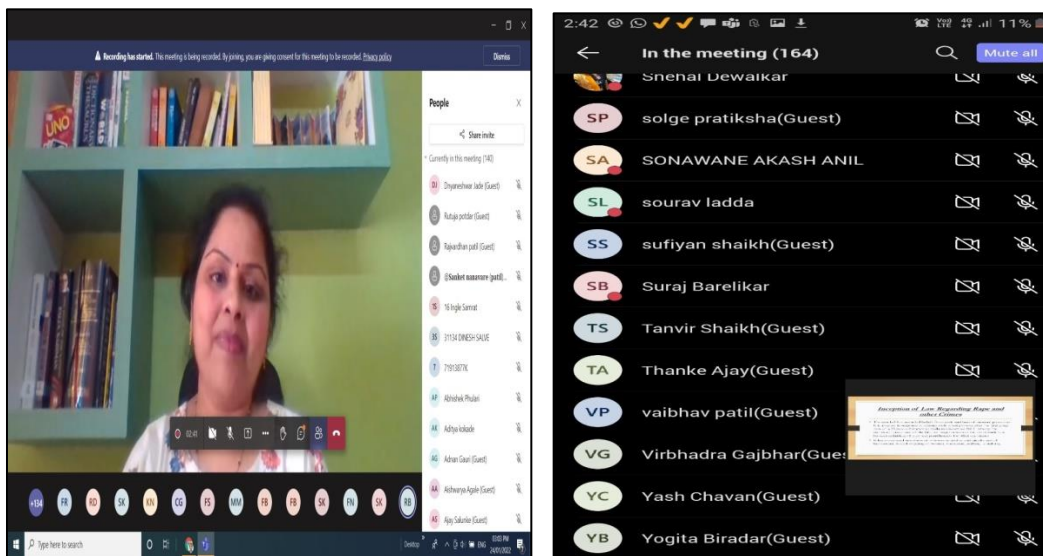
ACTIVITIES FOR INTERNATIONAL WOMEN EMPOWERMENT AND SENSITIZATION

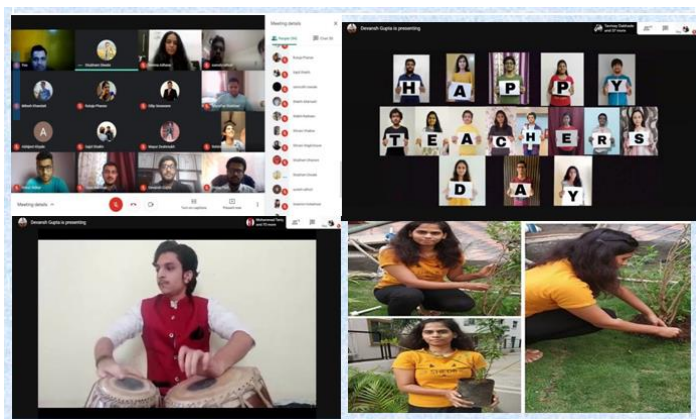
Report on “Teachers Day Celebration”

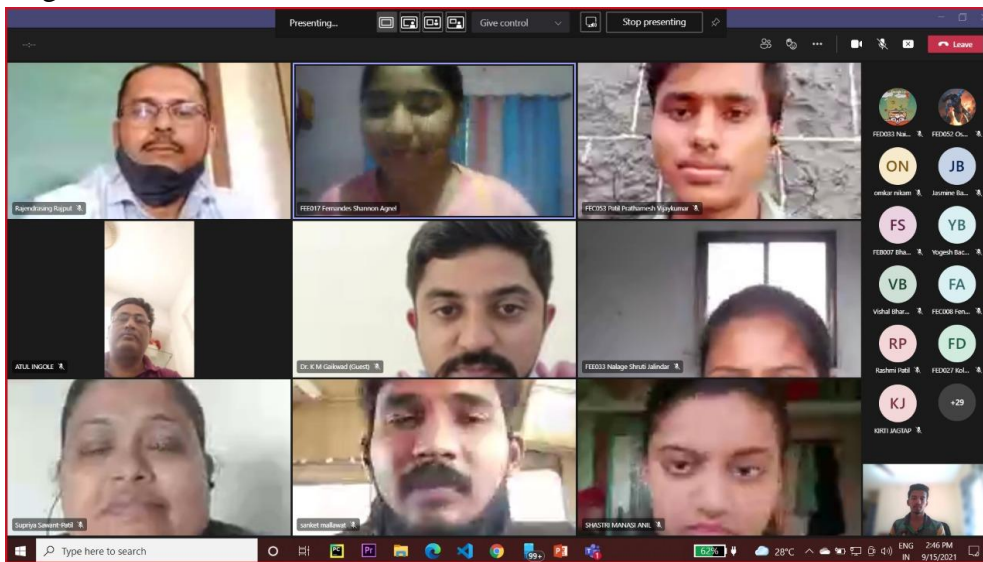
